Isabel V. Kindsvater age 89 of St. Clair died Sunday April 11, 2004.

Isabel was born in Mt. Clemens, July 11, 1914 to the late William and Nellie (nee Baumgartner) Quinn. She graduated from St. Joseph School of Nursing in 1935. She worked as nurse at St. Joseph Hospital, Ainsworth Industries and the St. Clair Community Hospital. She was the Vice president for Seaway Plastics from 1972 till 1999.
