Together, they owned and operated C & R Machine Products.

Deanna graduated from St. Stephens High School in Port Huron in 1955. She was president of the Camp Fire Girls in St. Clair for many years. Deanna was a member of St. Mary's Catholic Church, St. Mary's Church Parish Council, St. Mary's School Board and Daughter's of Isabella.
