**S**hirley K. Arnold, age 88, died Saturday, February 18, 2012 after suffering with Alzheimer's for the past 10 years. Mrs. Arnold was born December 16, 1923 in St. Clair to the late Peter and Mary "Mollie" (Shaw) Wood and graduated from St. Clair High School in 1942.
