## Joseph M. Holladay

SEP 15, 1942 - JAN 23, 2018

Joseph M. Holladay, age 75, of St. Clair, passed away peacefully January 23, 2018. He was born on September 15, 1942 in Louisville, KY to the late Joseph and Marie Holladay. He graduated from Marine City High School and Ferris State University. He married Sandra Hill in Marine City on February 6, 1965.

Joe had a long career supervising automotive manufacturing plants at Detroit Gasket and Huron Products. He was also very involved in his community as a past member of the East China School District Board, St. Clair Chamber of Commerce and various church committees.

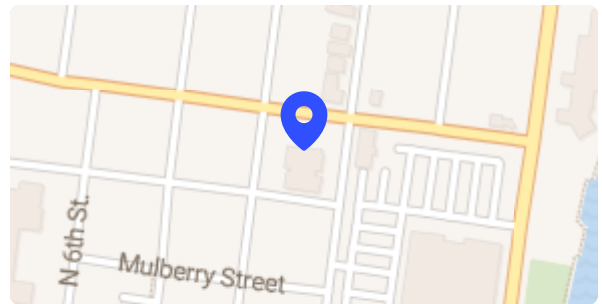

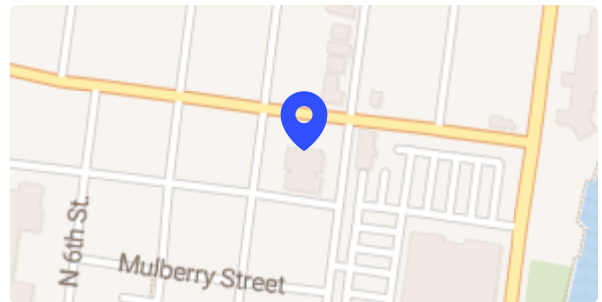
