Mr. Thomas Arthur Rissmann, 71 of Lewiston, Michigan died suddenly on January 16, 2019 at his home. He was born on February 15, 1947 in Detroit, Michigan to the late, Adolph and Renata Rissmann. He served his country proudly in the United States Army. 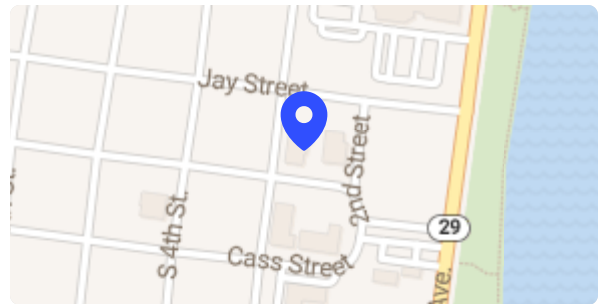

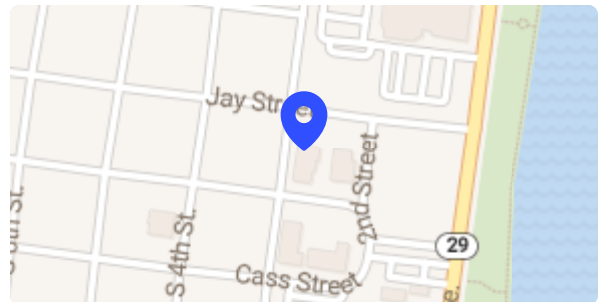

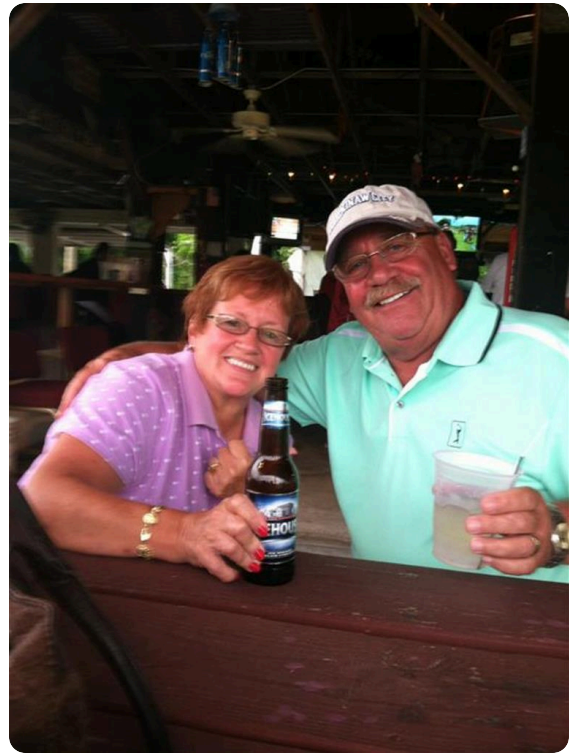
