Andrew Sadlowski, age 101 of China Twp., passed away on March 1, 2020. He celebrated his centennial birthday on January 28, 2019. Andrew was born to the late Walter Sr. and Josephine (Zychski) Sadlowski. He married Stella (Halogowski) on April 28, 1945. She preceded him in death in 2014.

Andy retired from Chris Craft Corporation after 41 years of service. He was an active area farmer for most of his life. Andy was a member of St. Mary's Catholic Church, where he ushered for over 50 years. He was a member of the St. Clair Knights of Columbus, Council #2251. Andrew was also an active member of the Futuristic Club for over 70 years. He was an avid Detroit Tiger fan. Andy also enjoyed traveling, which included trips to Florida, Hawaii and casino bus trips. 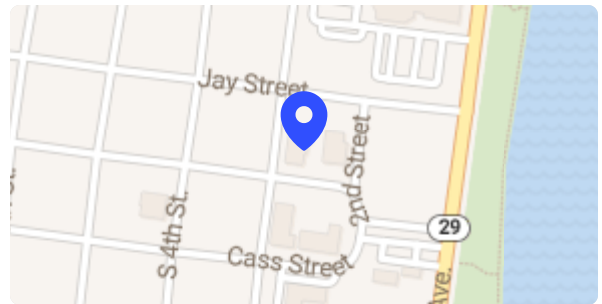

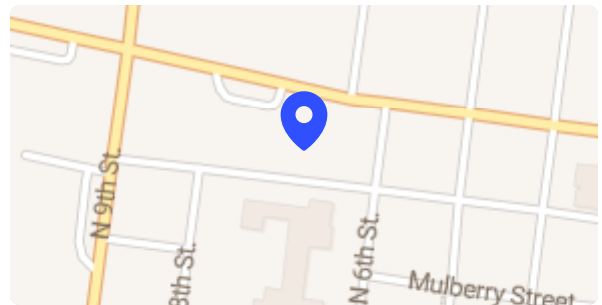

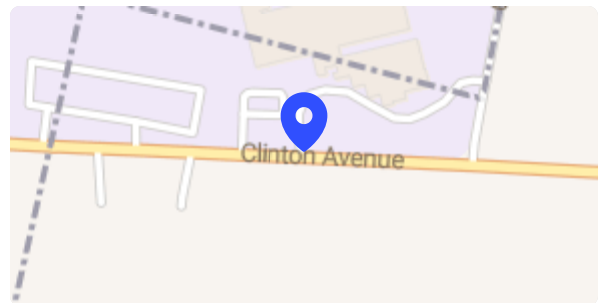
