her husband's retirement. In 2020 she returned to live in the Midwest.

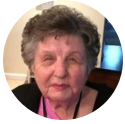
Gen was a dedicated woman, working various jobs in retail and hospitality to help provide for their eight children. Of her many roles in life, her greatest was that of being

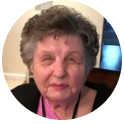

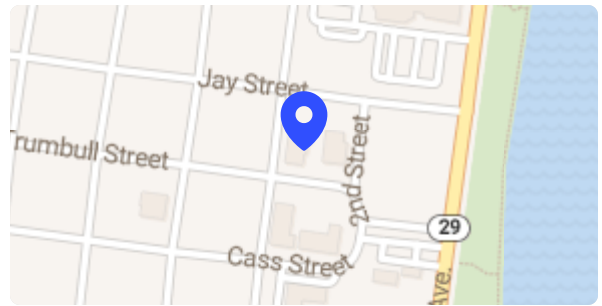
